
# "I am because you are"

During the course, you will be inspired by their stories, together with contributions by Nyenrode scholars and leading scholars from South Africa. #### Your accommodation

The Wildlife Forensic Academy is based at Buffelsfontein Game and Nature Reserve, one hour from Cape Town. The accommodation has Wi-Fi, bedding and towels. The water on the farm is safe to drink.





#### Costs

Participation fee for the program is **5.000,- euros**. Accommodation, meals and shuttle to and from Capetown airport are included; your ticket to Capetown and costs beyond what we offer in the program are not included.

Importantly, with your participation in this program, you support the work of the WFA among others by enabling the training of 30 African rangers at the Wildlife Forensic Academy. This way we create a circle of giving that will continue to thrive after your stay at Buffelsfontein.
